**Recipe –** Soak the Bengal Gram over night then boil them. Make a mixture of 2 tb.sp corn flour, 1tb sp. After half an hour fry the Bengal grams with mixture and keep it aside for cooling.

**Recipe for the gravy –** Take 4 tb. Sp oil in a pan and fry 2 sliced onion and capsicum , finely chopped ginger, garlic, green chilly, 4 drops of soya sauce, ½ tb sp red chilly sauce, 3 tb sp tomato sauce and mix well. Now add fried Bengal Gram and salt as per the taste and serve hot.
